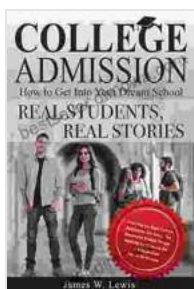

Prepare for the College Interview

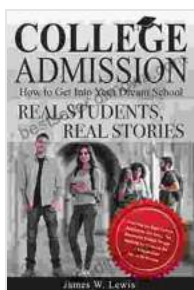

Don't Give Up

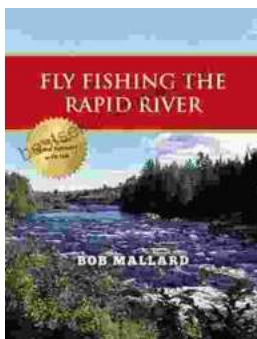
The college admission process can be long and stressful, but don't give up. If you work hard and stay positive, you'll eventually achieve your goal of getting into your dream school.

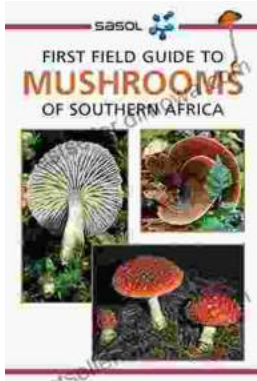
