


#### The Hungry Cat





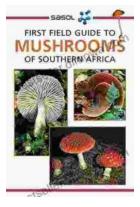
