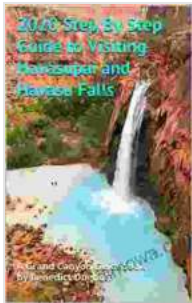

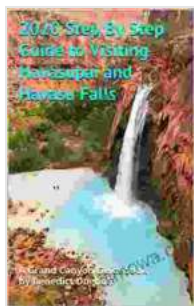
Additional Tips

Canyon. With careful planning, respect for the environment, and a thirst for exploration, you'll create memories that will last a lifetime.

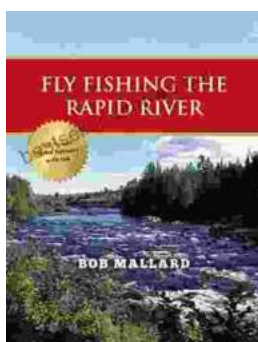
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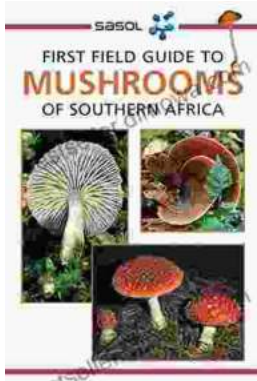
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
